SAY:

- What did the shepherds do after they saw Jesus?
- Who are the people in your life that need to know about Jesus?

Pray for your children to be excited about telling others about Jesus. Pray for your children to have strength and boldness to tell others about Jesus. Remind them that we know the best news ever - and it is our job to tell others so they know about their Savior!
